

Downtown Bellevue hosts concerts, an arts fair, and a jazz festival in summer; skating, snowflakes, and drummers in winter. Walking paths, a pedestrian-only corridor, and 130 works of public art make it easy to catch a glimpse of the city's creative nature.

- 1** The Bellevue Collection—encompassing Lincoln Square, Bellevue Square, and Bellevue Place—features 230-plus shopping and entertainment destinations.
- 2** The Shops at the Bravern is home to high-end and luxury shopping.
- 3** Old Bellevue—on Main Street—features independent boutiques, locally owned restaurants, and galleries.
- 4** The 20-acre Downtown Park has a half-mile walking loop and a cascading water feature that ends in a reflecting pool.
- 5** Meydenbauer Beach Park, on Lake Washington, has a fishing dock, picnic area, and a sandy swimming beach.
- 6** The performing and visual arts are on display year-round at Meydenbauer Center and Bellevue Arts Museum.
