
Freeway to freeway connections

Freeway to arterial connections








2040 Home-Work Person Trips To DOWNTOWN BELLEVUE

# **Potential Bellevue Master Plan improvements**

#### Direct connector ramps

- SR 520 HOV to I-405 express toll lanes
- I-90 HOV to I-405 express toll lanes

#### New general purpose ramps

- Braided ramps from westbound SR 520 to southbound I-405 and southbound I-405 to NE 10th Street
- On-ramp from 116th Avenue NE/Lake Hills Connector to southbound I-405
- SR 520/124<sup>th</sup> Ave NE interchange completion
- Northeast Sixth Street extension
- Options for new ramps/interchange configurations at NE Second Street/Main Street








# City Council Vision Priorities 2018-2020

- Continue to execute our transportation capital plans for future growth and mobility of the city. Use the funding provided by the Neighborhood Safety Connectivity and Congestion Levy to improve the safety, transportation and quality of life in neighborhoods.
- Advocate with the state Department of Transportation and regional agencies for acceleration of the I-405 Corridor Program, completion of SR 520, including Bellevue projects (i.e. NE 6th, 124th NE Interchange, braided ramps, Coal Creek Parkway).
- Continue to fund, design and build projects within the Downtown Transportation Plan, Wilburton Connection and BelRed.
- Continue the oversight of light rail construction and ensure that we implement an effective strategy for construction mitigation for neighborhoods, traffic and business.
