Bellevue Family 4th Information

Please take a moment to read the following information before joining us at the Bellevue Downtown Park on July 4th.

Amenities

A 20-acre oasis of green in the heart of Bellevue defines this elegant centerpiece of the Bellevue Parks System. A one-half mile promenade, bordered by a double row of shade trees and a stepped canal, brings one to the 240-foot wide waterfall that cascades into a reflecting pond. A 10-acre lawn area invites one to pause for family time with Bellevue's skyline and Mount Rainier in the background. The park's delightful play area and formal gardens add to family enjoyment and serve as a backdrop for community events.

Parking & Driving Directions

The Bellevue Downtown Park is located one block south of Bellevue Square on the corner of NE 4th Street and Bellevue Way in downtown Bellevue.

- ★ FREE parking is available at Bellevue Square, Lincoln Square, and Bellevue Place after 6 pm
- ★ Accessible Parking for individuals with a permit is provided at the Red Parking Lot at the West side of park off of 100th Avenue NE across from the Boys & Girls Club of Bellevue. Additional parking is available at the Free parking lots listed above.

Rules & Regulations

For the safety of everyone, please leave alcohol, fireworks, pets, and barbecues at home. The park has an irrigation system below the grass, so please do not drive anything into the ground. Leave the tent stakes at home. Small beach type tents, canopies, or other personal shelters are permitted on park grounds from 2pm – 8pm, but are not allowed at any time inside of the concert seating area in front of the main stage. All tents on park grounds must be lowered at 8:00pm to improve visibility for the public and for security purposes. **Please see the Parks and Recreation Facilities Code, Ch. 3.43 for a full list of rules and regulations regarding use of City parks.**

Pets

Loud fireworks, lots of people, and pets don't make a good combination. For the safety, health, and enjoyment of your pets and all festival goers, please leave your pets at home.

Unlawful or Prohibited Items

The following is prohibited in the Bellevue Downtown Park on July 4th

- ★ Dogs and other pets (between 2pm and 11pm)
- ★ Personal barbecues (food vendors are available during the event, or bring a picnic meal)
- ★ Alcoholic beverages
- ★ Fireworks
- ★ Sale of merchandise, food, or services, except by City of Bellevue Vendor Permit
- ★ Drones
- ★ Smoking

Please remember to bring a flashlight for safety. Pack it in—Pack it out.
